1. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- 1.1. In order that appointments can be made to key outside bodies such as charitable bodies, local partnerships and other organisations, a schedule of appointments is attached for consideration.
- 1.2. Appendix 1 details appointments by virtue of office, Appendix 2 miscellaneous appointments and Appendix 3 lists the organisations that no longer exist, or for which representation is no longer required. These schedules have been brought forward to this meeting so that the Council is not disadvantaged by any delay in making the appointments.
- 1.3. An annual review has been carried out, and external organisations have been consulted regarding future/ongoing representation on the bodies listed in the attached appendices.
- 1.4. Some appointments are renewed each municipal year and some run beyond this timescale.

2. REAPPOINTMENTS

- 2.1. The following term of office is due to expire, and the re-appointment has been included in Appendix 2:

- Rugby Welfare Charities – Councillor Roodhouse to 21 May 2029

2.2. Council is asked to approve the current appointments made by virtue of office and miscellaneous appointments subject to the appointments required to fill vacancies.

3. VACANCIES

3.1. Following the retirement of some appointed representatives, vacancies exist on the following bodies that require appointments to be made:

- Bilton Poor's Land and Other Charities – two replacement appointments are required. The charity requires that both representatives have a connection to Bilton Ward.
- Coventry Airport Consultative Committee
- Trustees of Hillmorton Charities – there is one vacancy that the charity wishes to nominate a replacement to and this is awaited.

4. APPOINTMENTS NO LONGER REQUIRED

4.1. There are two bodies for which appointments are no longer required. Rugby First Limited ceased to operate on 31 March 2026 and Warwickshire Local Councils Climate Emergency Partnership was disestablished by Warwickshire County Council in April 2026.

4.3 It is proposed that the above appointments are removed from the schedule of appointments made by virtue of office.
